Noncommunicable diseases (NCDs): The big challenge in public health





The MENA populations are most at risk of NCDs¹



The overall prevalence of **cardiovascular disease** in the Middle Eastern population was 10.1%, which is higher than the global prevalence (4.2%).²



In EMR, predominant **cancers** in males are lung (10.4%), liver (8.4%), and prostate **cancer** (8%), whereas major **cancers** among females are breast (34.7%), colorectal (5.7%), and cervical **cancer** (4.6%).³



Mental health illness contributes to 5.6% of the total disease burden in the region and 4.7% (3.7–5.6%) of total DALYs in the EMR in 2015, ranking as the ninth leading cause of disease burden.^{4,5}




73 million adults (20–79 years) are living with **diabetes**, whereas 27 million adults living with **diabetes** in the IDF MENA region are undiagnosed.⁶



COPD prevalence in the MENA region was 3.6% ranging from 1.9% in UAE to 6.1% in Syria.⁷



Every 2 seconds, someone between the age of 30 and 70 dies prematurely from a NCD⁸






